Q1.1. There is not enough space on a map to show mountains, rivers, lakes, bridges, dams, temples, churches, and railway track. So different signs and symbols are used to give information on a map.

Different colours are used to show various thing on a map. Maps follow a common scheme of colours. This colour scheme is used for maps all over the world.

2. A globe has some limitations.

- A large globe is difficult to carry.
- Space is limited and details cannot be shown on a globe.
- It is not possible to make a globe for a part of the earth.
- Only one side of the earth can be seen at one time.

3. The earth is spherical in shape and its surface is curved. A curved surface cannot be shown correctly on a flat surface such as paper. It is not possible to make an accurate map from a curved surface. That's why maps are less accurate than a globe.

4. The people who make maps are called cartographers.

5. Maps can be of different types.

- Physical maps:- Maps that show physical features such as mountains, plains, plateaus and water bodies are known as physical maps.
- Political maps:- Maps that show different countries, states and their capitals are called political maps.
