Topic – Nouns

In the previous discussed modules and videos we came to know about nouns and its types.

A word that identifies a person, place or thing.

The simple definition is: **a person, place or thing**. Here are some examples:

- **person:** man, woman, teacher, John, Mary
- **place:** home, office, town, countryside, America
- **thing:** table, car, banana, money, music, love, dog, monkey

Types of Nouns

Common Nouns and Proper Nouns

Common Nouns

Most nouns are common nouns. Common nouns refer to people, places and things in general like chair *or* dog. Any noun that is not a name is a common noun.

Examples: teacher, car, music, danger

- Have you seen my **dog**?
- The **books** are on your **desk**.

Proper Nouns

Names of people, places or organizations are proper nouns. Your name is a proper noun. London is a proper noun.

Rule: Proper nouns always start with a capital letter.

Examples: Jane, Thailand, Sunday, James Bond, Einstein, Superman, Game of Thrones, Shakespeare

- Let me introduce you to **Mary**. • The capital of **Italy** is **Rome**
- I was born in **November**.
