Number form

Learn the different Forms of a Number - Standard Form, Numeral Form, Expanded Form, Unit Form, Word Form

See the difference between standard form, unit form, expanded form, and word form. Example:

Standard Form: 432

Numeral Form: 432

Expanded Form: $400 + 30 + 2$

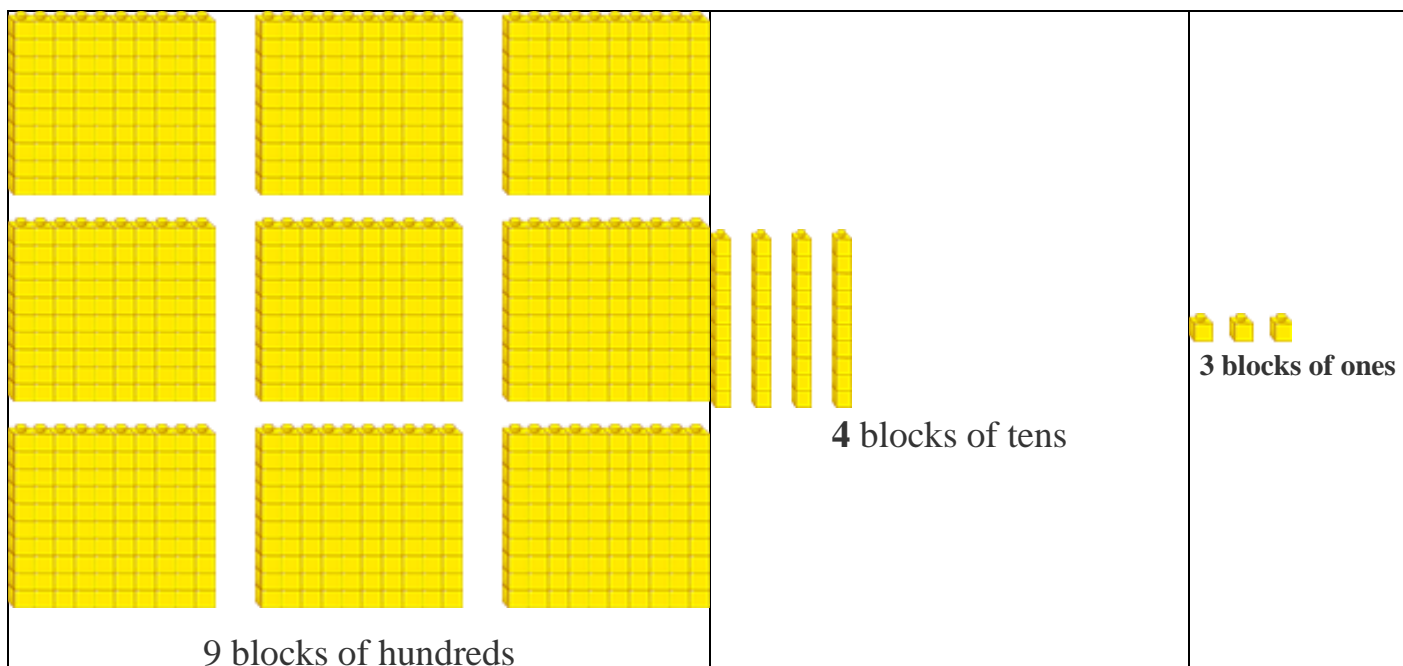
Unit Form: 4 hundreds 3 tens 2 ones

Word Form: Four hundred thirty-two **Expanded**

Form

What is Expanded Form?

In the expanded form, we break up a **number** according to their **place value** and expand it to show the value of each **digit**. For example, the expanded form of 943 is given.



9 hundreds 4 tens 3 ones

Expanded Form: $900 + 40 + 3$
