Shark Fact File



- Found in all the oceans, except the Antarctic, where the water is too cold
- Almost any size, from 15cm to 15 metres
- 250 species, only 30 are known to attack humans
- Look almost the same as those that lived 160 million years ago
- Identified by: dorsal fin, two rows of teeth, black eyes, sleek shape
- Eats almost any animal, including other sharks
- Good eyesight and sense of smell





Most sharks are carnivores, or meat eaters. They eat fish, and sea mammals like seals, and dolphins.

Some sharks are scary and dangerous, but some are nice and gentle. These are the largest sharks.



Sharks have very sharp teeth and they loose them up to 7 times a year! They have over 30,00 teeth in their life. Sharks can't stop swimming or they will sink.
